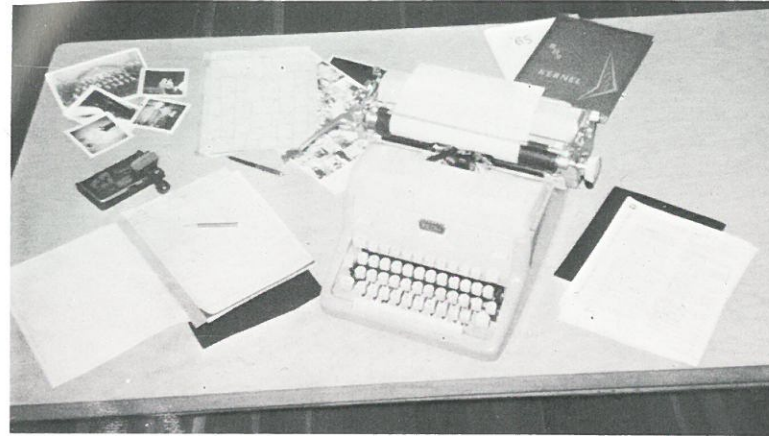


Foreword

The Student Council undertook the revising of the School Constitution this year. We also set up a homeroom schedule to eliminate noon hour meetings.

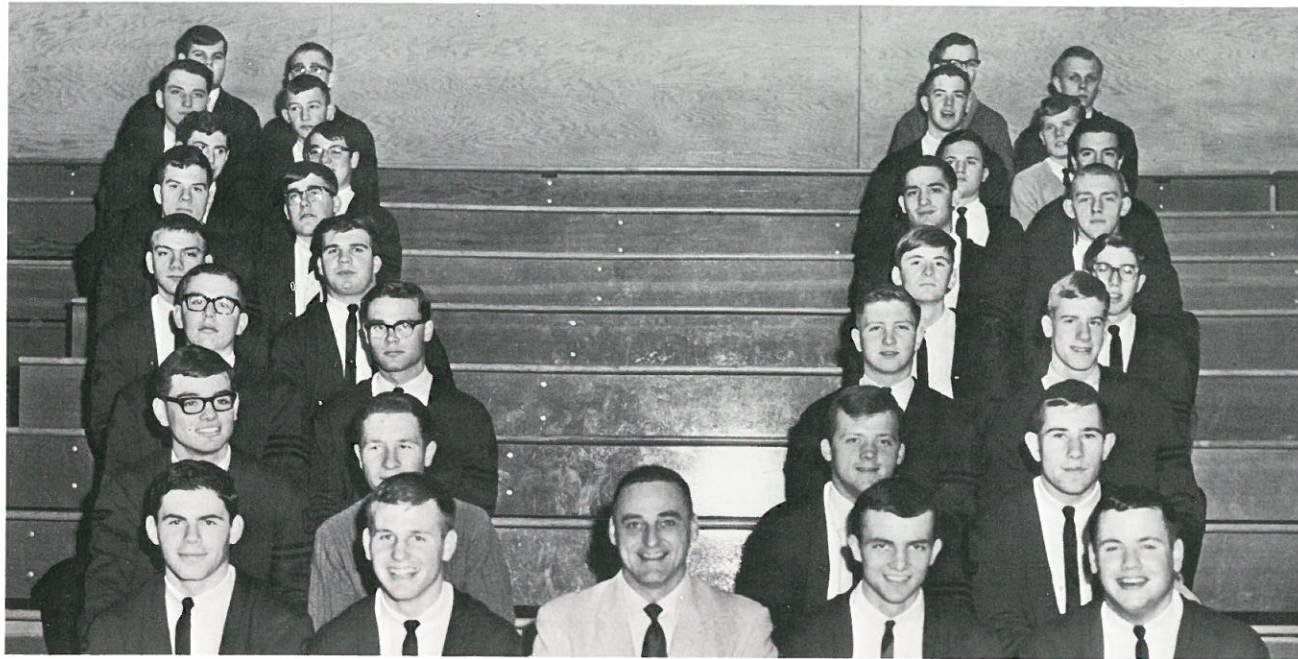
