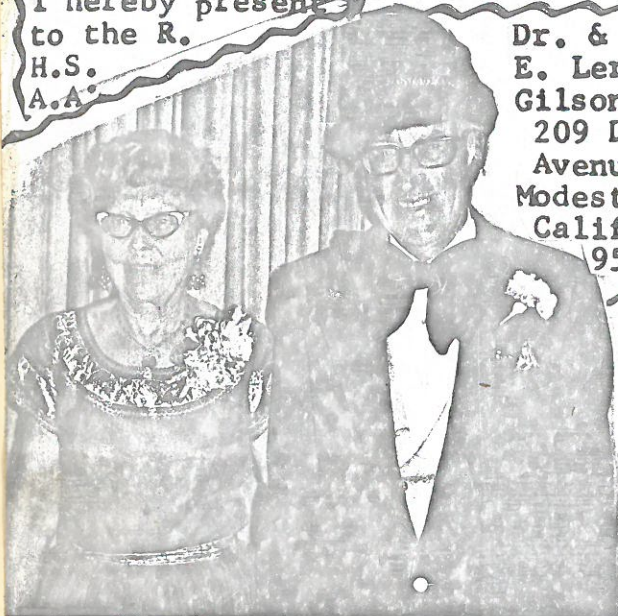

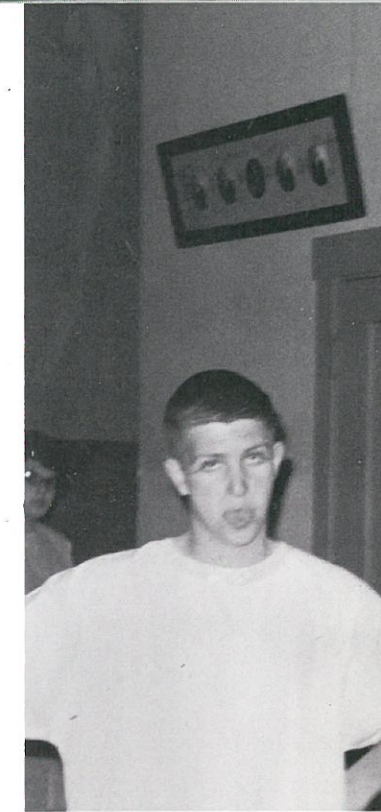
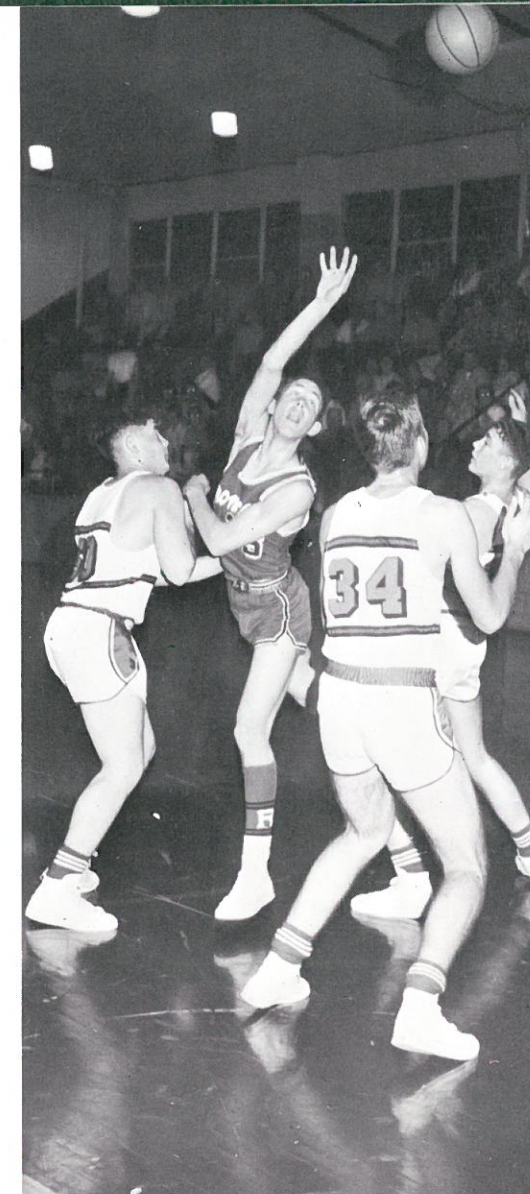

Another carefree summer has elapsed and once again one hundred and ninety six students have congregated in the halls of RHS to endeavor to better prepare themselves for their future.

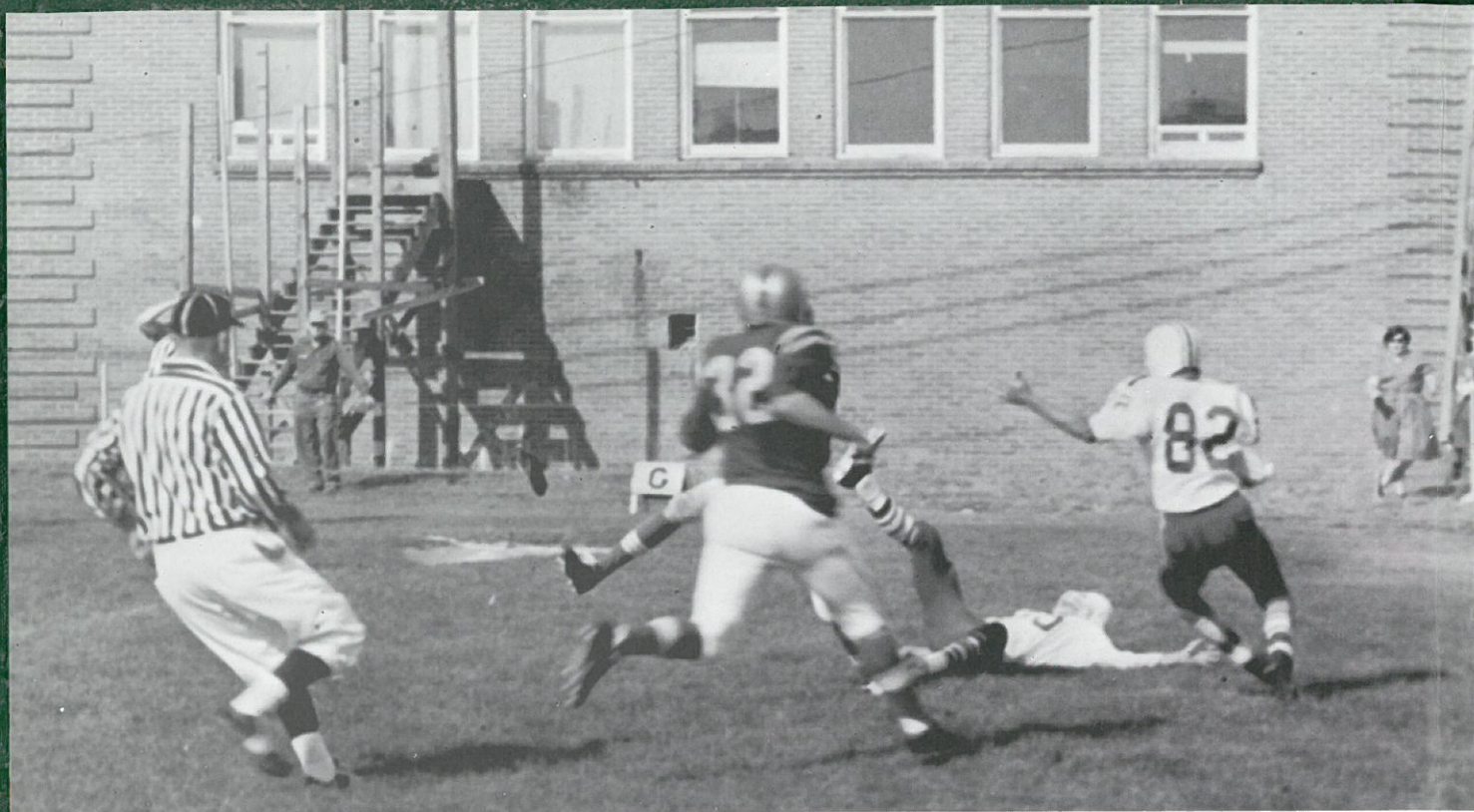
