
Time can be divided into past, present, and future. The past can truly become a source of wisdom to guide us in present and future judgements and actions.




Student Council

It strives to bring the community closer to the school's activities.







They do various jobs to help Mr. Hopkins and the school. They collect money at all athletic events and help to promote school spirit.


