## MEMORIAM

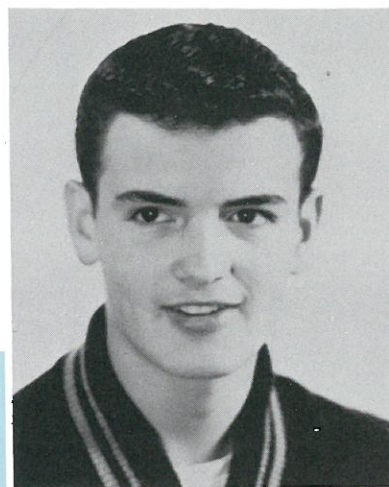
There are places within our ranks reserved for three who, today, would be with us in body, had they not been intercepted by the Great Creator of Time.

In this small space we wish to humbly pay tribute to our friends, who were once — and still are — a part of us in the drama of life.

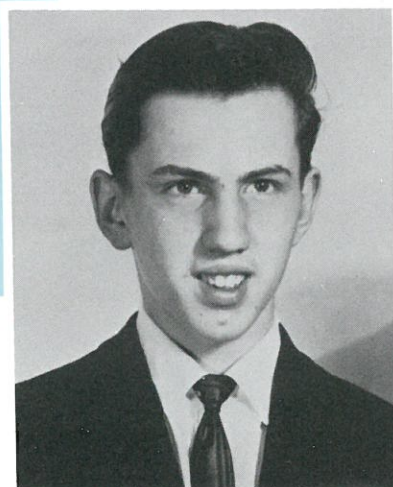

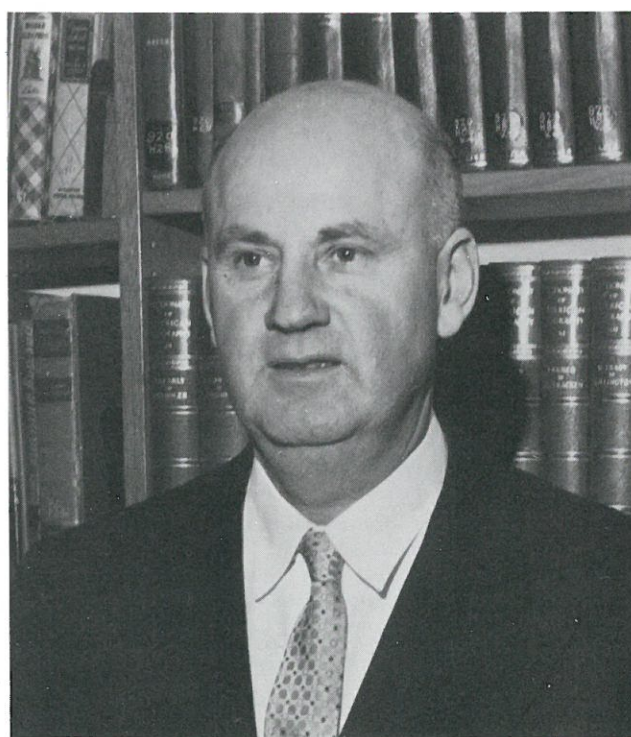

May the experiences of every student in Ritzville High School contribute to building strong character and responsible citizenship.

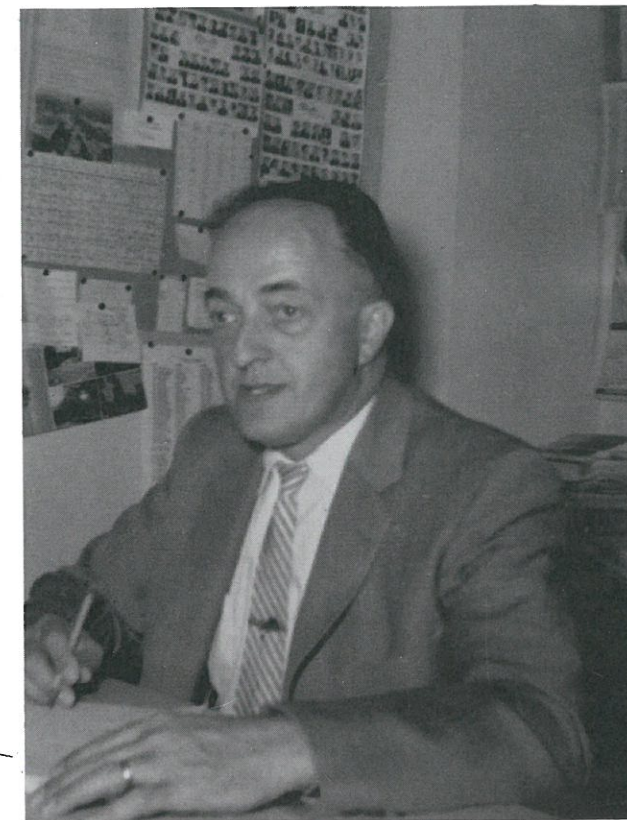
