The old high school building has seen its last classes, but the memories will never fade. Although the future of the building is uncertain the school which proudly served Ritzville students for 79 years will never be forgotten.

Construction of the middle section and the basement began in 1910. The wings housing the gym, band room, and auditorium were built in the spring of 1927. The first class to graduate from the building was the class of 1911. The classes of 1982 and 1983 ended an era as the last class to graduate and the last to attend classes in the building.

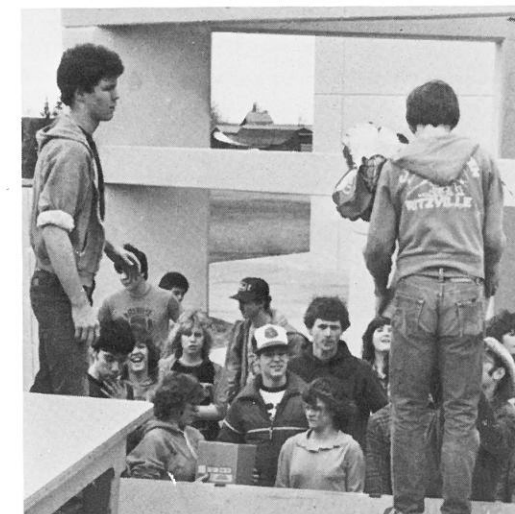

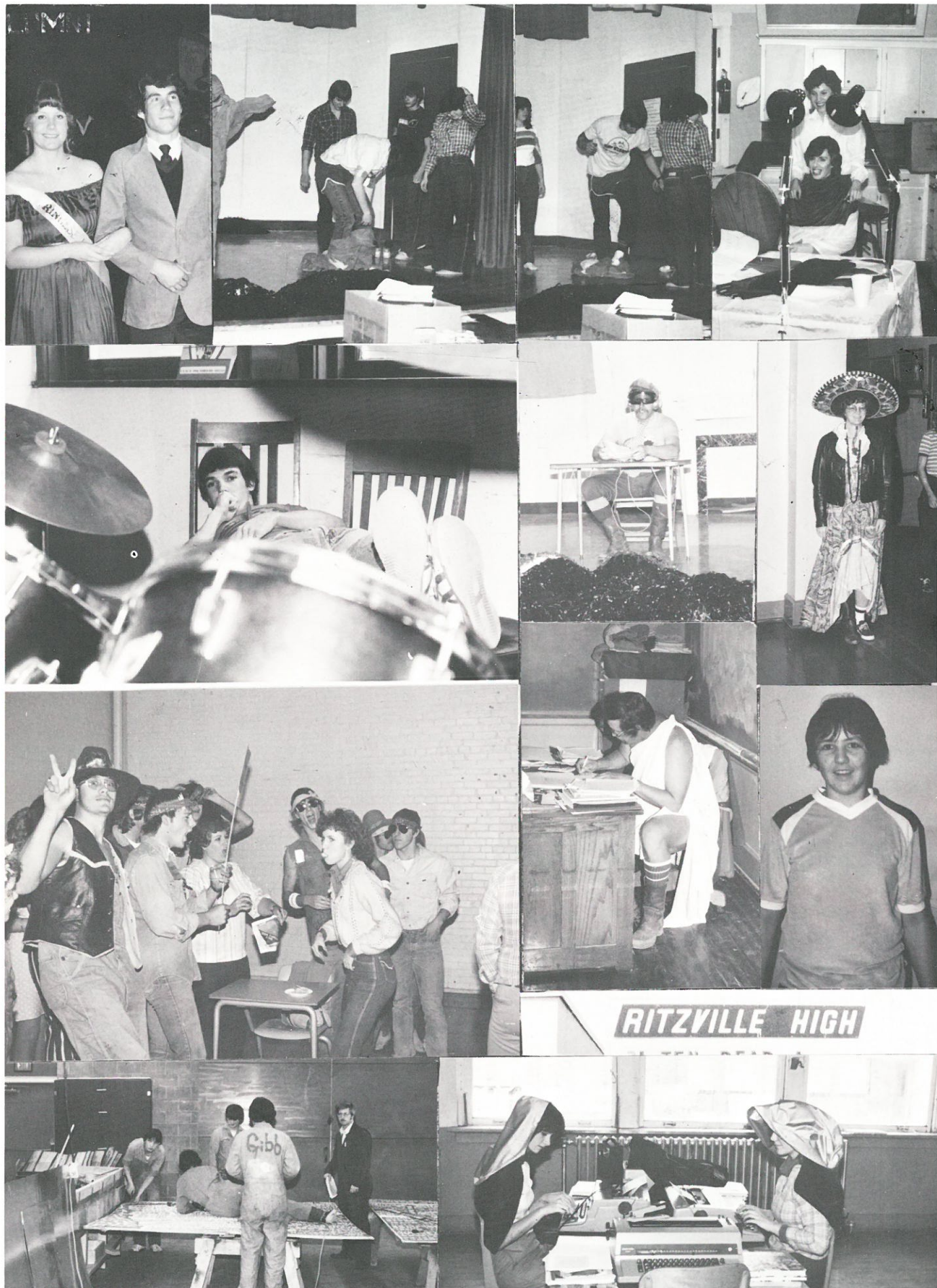
