# FOOTBALL

The 1985 Football season was an unexpected surprise for the students of Ritzville High School. In what was supposed to be a rebuilding year for the Broncos, they accomplished more than people thought. Coach Lynch went into the season with the feeling of "We could be 0-8". They ended up being in the quarter-finals of the state play-offs, after winning the Bi-County championship for the sixth straight year. During their march to the playoffs, they beat Liberty, at Liberty for the first time since 1976, and Reardan for a 5-0 league record.

In the playoffs, the Broncos faced the Kittitas Coyotes in a rematch of last years semi-final game. But this year, the Broncos came out on top 21-19. The Fighting Irish of DeSales were the next in line for the Broncos. DeSales unleashed a high-powered offense and a solid defense to stifle the Broncos 38-21.

The surprise for the year was definitely the effectiveness of running backs Matt Koch (843 yards) and Ben Stevens (744 yards). The Bronco high powered offense stacked up 243 points to their opponents 117.

All in all, 1985 turned out to be a very successful year for the Broncos of Ritzville High.







We have tried several new things with the 85-86 Kernal and I hope that it has added to your enjoyment.


I would like to apologize to any organization that feels it was not fully covered in this book. We tried our best to get all the pictures we thought we would need.






